For the past 15 years he has helped students examine solutions to poverty by taking them to live at homeless shelters, the Navajo and Lakota nations and to Kingston, Jamaica. Dr. Myers-Lipton is currently on a nation-wide speaking tour and the founder of the Gulf Coast Civic Works Project an effort to bring 100,000 jobs to rebuild the Gulf Coast.
